



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2017/170

Hollow Structural Sections

Exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand

Withdrawal of application for Accelerated Review of anti-dumping measures

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 9 November 2017, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, initiated an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to hollow structural sections exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand), in so far as they relate to a new exporter, Atlantic Pipe Company Limited (Atlantic).

Notice of my decision to not reject the application and to initiate the accelerated review was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (Commission) website on 9 November 2017.

In a letter dated 19 November 2017, Atlantic advised the Commission that it has decided to withdraw its application for accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to it.

Since Atlantic has withdrawn its application for accelerated review, I have ceased the accelerated review of anti-dumping measures applicable to Atlantic.

Securities

Cessation of this accelerated review means that any securities put in place at the initiation of the accelerated review and taken under section 42 of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) pursuant to subsection 269ZH(b) of the Act, will be converted to interim dumping duty.

The applicable rate of duty is the 'Uncooperative and all other exporters' rate specified in the dumping duty notice applying to hollow structural sections exported to Australia from Thailand¹, as altered from time to time. Future exports of hollow structural sections to Australia by Atlantic will also be subject to this rate of duty.
