ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2019/27

Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel

Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Findings in Relation to an Accelerated Review of Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Measures

Notice under subsection 269ZG(3) of the Customs Act 1901

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed an accelerated review, which commenced on 20 November 2018, of the anti-dumping measures applying to Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel (the goods) exported to Australia by Zhejiang Huada New Materials Co., Ltd (Huada) from the People's Republic of China.

Recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 500* (REP 500).

I, Karen Andrews, the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered REP 500 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts and law set out in REP 500.

Under subsection 269ZG(3) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act), that, with effect from 20 November 2018 the dumping duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from China is taken to have effect as if the original dumping duty notice had applied to Huada but that I had fixed different variable factors relevant to the determination of dumping duty in respect of Huada.

For the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), the original countervailing duty notice is to remain unchanged.

The duty that has been determined is an amount worked out in accordance with the floor price duty method as detailed in the table below.

Particulars of the dumping and countervailing margins established for Huada is set out in the following table.

Exporter/country	Dumping Margin	Subsidy Margin	Duty Method
Zhejiang Huada New Materials Co., Ltd - China	0%	21.7%	Dumping - Floor price duty method
