SPECIAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES

**AFFIRMATION OF DECISION TO TAKE ANTI-DUMPING ACTION  
AGAINST IMPORTS OF POLYVINYL CHLORIDE HOMOPOLYMER  
RESIN EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM HUNGARY AND THE  
REPUBLIC OF KOREA**

The Trade Measures Review Officer (TMRO) has conducted a review, under s. 269ZZK of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), of the decision of the Minister for Justice and Customs (the Minister) to publish, on 23 March 2000, dumping duty notices under subsections 269TG(1) and (2) of the Act in respect of imports of polyvinyl chloride homopolymer resin (PVC) exported from the Republic of Korea (Korea) by LG International Corporation of Korea (LG).

The Minister has considered the TMRO's report and recommendation. On 4 August 2000 the Minister affirmed her decision to publish dumping duty notices in respect of PVC exported from Korea by LG.
