

## Australian Customs Dumping Notice No. 2000/58

**CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XVB** 

## AFFIRMATION OF DECISION TO TAKE ANTI DUMPING ACTION AGAINST IMPORTS OF LINEAR LOW DENSITY POLYETHYLENE FROM INDONESIA BUT NOT AGAINST IMPORTS FROM KOREA, MALAYSIA AND SAUDI ARABIA

The Trade Measures Review Officer (TMRO) has conducted a review, under s. 269ZZK of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), of the decision of the Minister for Justice and Customs (the Minister) to publish dumping duty notices under subsections 269TG(1) and (2) of the Act in respect of imports of linear low density polyethylene (LLDPE) exported from Indonesia and not to take anti-dumping action against imports of LLDPE from Korea, Malaysia and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

The Minister has considered the TMRO's report and recommendation. On 28 November 2000 the Minister affirmed her decision to publish dumping duty notices in respect of imports of LLDPE polyethylene exported from Indonesia and not to take antidumping action against imports of LLDPE exported from Korea, Malaysia and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
