



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/99

Wind Towers Exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 28 August 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of wind towers exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2013/68. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 16 December 2013. The SEF will set out the facts on which the Anti-Dumping Commissioner (Commissioner) proposes to base his recommendations to the Minister for Industry (the Minister).

Due to extensions of time allowed for various interested parties to supply information, public holidays in the nominated countries as well as the Commission's workload across multiple verification visits, the Commissioner requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than **4 February 2014**. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 21 March 2014.
