



## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/84**

### **Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes Exported from Italy Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts**

#### ***Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB***

On 10 July 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of prepared or preserved tomatoes exported to Australia from Italy.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2013/59. This ADN is available on the internet at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au).

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 28 October 2013. The SEF will set out the facts on which the Commission proposes to base its recommendations to the Minister for Industry (the Minister).

Due to the complexity of the issues surrounding the investigation, as well as extensions of time allowed for various interested parties to supply information, the Commissioner requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 16 December 2013. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 30 January 2014.
